USE OF SALVAGED, AFTERMARKET AND REMANUFACTURED SUPPLEMENTAL RESTRAINT SYSTEMS (SRS) & COMPONENTS

New Ford Motor Company original equipment parts that have been tested by Ford Motor Company are critical for supplemental restraint systems and related components used in collision repairs to provide their designed safety and functionality. The use of salvaged, aftermarket, remanufactured or reverse-engineered restraint parts is not validated by Ford Motor Company and may compromise the designed safety and functionality of the SRS system.

 or non-Ford Motor Company original equipment parts lack this vital traceability.
- Design Integrity: Even minor variations in components—down to model-year revisions—can disrupt the timing, deployment or coverage of an airbag system.
