

# Tire Replacement Position Statement

**This document outlines Lucid Motors' position on the replacement of tires on any Lucid vehicle involved in a collision.**

Lucid Motors requires all installed tires on any Lucid vehicle involved in a collision to be inspected and then replaced if they display any of the following types of damage:

- Scuffs to the sidewall
- Rips or tears to the sidewall or tread
- Punctures to the sidewall or treads
- Bubbles or raised areas of the sidewall
- Flat spots on the surface of a tire

Lucid Motors also requires any corresponding tire on a damaged wheel that warrants wheel replacement to be thoroughly inspected for damage. Lucid Motors does not approve reinstalling a tire from a damaged wheel that warrants replacement onto a new wheel if the tire is showing signs of damage. Additionally, any remaining tires must be replaced if the difference in tread depth between the newly replaced tire and the other remaining tires is greater than 2/32" (even if the tires show no signs of physical damage), as measured with a proper tread depth gauge.

This statement applies to every tire that comes equipped with all Lucid Vehicles:

## 19" Tires:

## 20" Tires:

- P11-S1E400-00 TIRE, 245/40R20, MICHELIN PSEV, SUMMER
- P11-S1F800-00 TIRE, 265/40R20, MICHELIN PSEV, SUMMER

## 21" Tires:

- P11-S1M100-02 TIRE, 245/35R21, PIRELLI PZERO, SUMMER
- P11-S1N500-02 TIRE, 265/35R21, PIRELLI PZERO, SUMMER
- P11-S1R600-01 TIRE, 295/30R21 MICHELIN PS4S SUMMER
