

Use of Aftermarket/Salvaged Parts

This document outlines Lucid Motors' position regarding the use of Aftermarket/Salvaged Parts.

Lucid Motors vehicles, systems, and components are engineered, tested, and manufactured to meet global regulatory requirements and internal Lucid standards for durability, noise, vibration, and harshness (NVH), occupant protection, and overall safety. The structural integrity and performance of each Lucid vehicle relies on strict adherence to these design specifications.

To ensure Lucid vehicles are repaired to their intended safety and performance standards following a collision, Lucid provides engineering-approved repair procedures and Certified Lucid Parts. These parts are built to the same specifications as those originally installed on new vehicles. Use of Certified Lucid Parts and approved repair methods enables restoration of the vehicle as close as possible to its pre-accident condition.

Lucid Motors does not approve the use of salvaged, recycled, or aftermarket parts in the repair of Lucid vehicles. The use of such components introduces significant risks, including but not limited to:

- Compromised structural integrity, especially in designed crush zones, due to previous damage or repairs.
- Refinish inconsistencies, such as multiple paint layers, which may interfere with part durability and Advanced Driver Assistance Systems (ADAS) performance.
- Extended repair times, resulting from variable part conditions, missing components, or additional preparation requirements.
- Unknown storage and handling history, which may affect part reliability and integration.
- Environmental exposure, outside Lucid Motors' design and validation parameters.

Lucid Motors DOES NOT approve the use of the following:

Aftermarket Parts

Aftermarket parts are defined as replacement components not produced by the original equipment manufacturer (OEM) used by Lucid in the assembly of its vehicles. These parts may differ in quality, fit, performance, and warranty coverage. Lucid Motors does not recognize aftermarket parts as equivalent replacements, and they are not covered under by any Lucid express warranty. Their use is not authorized and may compromise vehicle safety, system performance, and overall repair integrity.

Salvaged, Recycled, and Used Components

These include parts removed from vehicles that have been previously damaged or retired from service. Lucid Motors cannot verify the safety, performance, or durability of these components. As such, salvaged, recycled, and used parts—including electronic control modules, safety-critical components, and high-voltage parts—are not approved for use in Lucid vehicle repairs. Use of these parts may compromise structural integrity, occupant safety, and proper vehicle function.
